**Passive:** The project will have been completed by him by next week.

52. **Active:** I had done my homework before the teacher arrived.

**Passive:** My homework had been done by me before the teacher arrived.

## 53-100: জটিল বাক্য এবং বিভিন্ন টেনস

53. **Active:** She will have cooked dinner by the time we arrive.

**Passive:** Dinner will have been cooked by her by the time we arrive.

54. **Active:** They had completed the project before the deadline.

**Passive:** The project had been completed by them before the deadline.

55. Active: He will not have finished the work by tomorrow.

**Passive:** The work will not have been finished by him by tomorrow.

56. **Active:** The children had broken the vase before their parents came.

**Passive:** The vase had been broken by the children before their parents came.

57. **Active:** We shall have cleaned the house by evening.

**Passive:** The house shall have been cleaned by us by evening.

58. **Active:** She had written the letter before sunset.

**Passive:** The letter had been written by her before sunset.

59. **Active:** He will have repaired the car by tonight.

**Passive:** The car will have been repaired by him by tonight.

60. **Active:** They had planted the trees before the rains began.

**Passive:** The trees had been planted by them before the rains began.

Passive: The parcel shall have been received by me by tomorrow morning.

**Passive:** The book had not been returned by him before the librarian asked.

67. **Active:** She will have completed the project before the manager checks it.

Passive: The project will have been completed by her before the manager checks it.

68. Active: The team had won the match before it started raining.

**Passive:** The match had been won by the team before it started raining.

69. **Active:** They will have sent the invitation before the event.

Passive: The invitation will have been sent by them before the event.

70. **Active:** He had already signed the agreement before they arrived.

Passive: The agreement had already been signed by him before they arrived.

71. **Active:** She will have prepared the report before the meeting.

Passive: The report will have been prepared by her before the meeting.

72. **Active:** They had discussed the issue before the deadline.

**Passive:** The issue had been discussed by them before the deadline.

73. **Active:** I will have booked the tickets by the time you come.

**Passive:** The tickets will have been booked by me by the time you come.

74. **Active:** They had informed the guests about the change in schedule.

Passive: The guests had been informed about the change in schedule by them.

75. **Active:** She will have completed her studies by next year.

**Passive:** Her studies will have been completed by her by next year.

76. **Active:** We had visited the museum before it closed.

**Passive:** The museum had been visited by us before it closed.

77. **Active:** The workers will have repaired the road before the festival.

#### Complex Sentences with Conditional Clauses (81-90)

81. **Active:** If he calls you, inform me immediately.

**Passive:** If you are called by him, inform me immediately.

82. **Active:** If they complete the project, they will get the payment.

**Passive:** If the project is completed by them, the payment will be given.

83. **Active:** If she had informed us earlier, we would have helped her.

**Passive:** If we had been informed earlier by her, she would have been helped.

84. **Active:** If you practice daily, you will improve.

Passive: If practice is done daily by you, improvement will occur.





85. **Active:** If they had planned properly, they would have succeeded.

**Passive:** If proper planning had been done by them, success would have been achieved.

86. **Active:** If you follow the instructions, you will pass the test.

**Passive:** If the instructions are followed by you, the test will be passed.

87. Active: If he submits the form, he will be admitted.

Passive: If the form is submitted by him, admission will be granted.

88. Active: If you had taken care, this accident could have been avoided.

Passive: If care had been taken by you, this accident could have been avoided.

89. **Active:** If they invite us, we will attend the function.

**Passive:** If we are invited by them, the function will be attended by us.

90. Active: If the rain stops, we will go for a walk.

Passive: If the rain is stopped, a walk will be taken by us.

91. Active: Someone has stolen my wallet.

Passive: My wallet has been stolen by someone.

92. Active: Nobody will blame you.

Passive: You will not be blamed by anybody.

93. **Active:** People say he is honest.

**Passive:** It is said that he is honest.

94. **Active:** The judge declared him guilty.

**Passive:** He was declared guilty by the judge.

95. **Active:** Everyone loves a cheerful person.

**Passive:** A cheerful person is loved by everyone.

96. Active: Someone has posted the letter.

**Passive:** The letter has been posted by someone.
